

Chalkboard Wallpaper

ITEMS YOU WILL NEED

- Chalkboard Wallpaper
- Surface to apply Chalkboard Wallpaper
- Scissors
- Water
- Sponge

STEP ONE—Cut the Wallpaper

- Using a scissors, cut the wallpaper to the size and shape that you want to apply to your surface.

STEP TWO—Clean the surface

- Using a sponge and water, clean the surface area that you will be applying the wallpaper to.

STEP THREE—Wet the Wallpaper

- Using a sponge, wet the back side of the wallpaper with water. Be sure to get all areas of the wallpaper wet, paying extra attention to the edges and corners.

Note: while you want the back of the wallpaper to be wet, you do not want it dripping as this will increase the amount of time it takes for the wallpaper to fully adhere to the surface.

STEP FOUR—Place the wallpaper

- Place the wallpaper on the surface that you are applying to it. You can move the wallpaper around until you have found the placement that you are happy with.

STEP FIVE: Adhere the Wallpaper

- Apply steady pressure starting at the center of the wallpaper and moving your way outward. Pay extra attention to the corners and edges of the wallpaper to ensure proper adhesion.
- Continue applying pressure until the wallpaper feels securely adhered to the wall.

Once the wallpaper is adhered to the wall, you are free to use it!

NOTES

- Any chalk product that works with a chalkboard can also be used with chalkboard wallpaper, including chalk sticks and chalk markers.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- For the best removal of chalk from the wallpaper, use Windex or Magic Erasers. However, water can also be used.

REMOVING INSTUCTIONS

- Chalk wallpaper is easy to remove, mess free, and will not ruin surfaces.
- To properly remove, begin peeling off at a corner of the wallpaper and continue to pull entire area up until the wallpaper is completely removed.



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
